

Addendum to agenda items SP5b and SP5c

This paper sets out amendments made at the Core Strategy Meeting on 7 December 2011 to reports presented under agenda items SP5b and SP5c.

Agenda Item SP5b

Page 11, Point 5) Travellers:

Amend text: 'Support needs of this client group are being met through specialist services not funded by Supporting People. Where individuals or families are at risk of homelessness or become homeless, their needs are being met under provision for homeless people.'

Page 14, Point j) Young people at risk:

Amend text: [...] 'with an exception of reported growing pressure in Cherwell and Oxford for those 18 years old and over'.

Point 15) Point f):

Add text – after '[...] primarily due to higher supply of services for single homeless people' ... 'which masks the fact that these services offer county wide access'.

Page 16, Intention 1:

Add text in the fifth column – 'Achieve financial savings linked to this pathway of services in the Mental Health Pool financial plan'.

Page 17, Intention 3:

Amend text in the third column, first sentence – 'Implement recommendations of the 2011-12 Supporting People strategic review of these services'.

Page 18, Intention 6:

Amend text in the third column, first sentence – 'Maintain or remodel current service configuration, in line with recommendations of 2011-12 Supporting People strategic review'.

Amend text in the third column, second sentence – 'Consider recommendations [...]']'.

Page 18, Intention 7:

Amend text in the third column, first sentence – 'Maintain or remodel current service configuration, in line with recommendations of 2011-12 Supporting People strategic review'.

Page 19, Intention 9:

Amend text in the third column, first sentence – 'Address gaps and pressures identified in 2011 needs and gaps analysis by matching supply to demand in a most effective way'.

Amend text in the third column, second sentence – 'Adopt a whole system approach to remodelling and commissioning new services, taking into account other local resources'.

Throughout the Commissioning intentions table:

Amend text in the fifth column, where applicable – Replace 'More equitable geographical distribution of services' with 'Match provision to demand in a most effective way'.

Agenda Item SP5c

Page 25, Point 6:

Amend text – Replace '2013-14' with '2014-15'.

Page 26, Point 8:

Amend text in the third bullet point – 'We should move away from micro managing service delivery towards monitoring outcomes and quality, together with service users and local stakeholders; while making sure that services are cost effective and sustainable for the duration of contracts we award'.

Page 28, Table at the top of the page:

Amend text in the first column, last sentence: 'Contingency target delivered in 2011-12 is committed spend for 2012-13'.

Page 31, Point 20:

Add fifth bullet point – 'points 12-15 set out the preferred option recommended by the members of the Core Strategy Group'.
