In my case, any visits I make to Harriers school which are not drop offs to morning clubs, I park at Banbury Tennis Club and walk through Easington Park (advised by the school).</p> <p>For these morning clubs there would be insufficient time to park at the Tennis club, drop off at the extra-curricular morning club, then walk back to the Tennis club and get to work on time. In such cases you risk children not being able to attend clubs because of the 08.15 enforcement time. I propose either there is an exemption for drop offs to these extra curricular clubs, or the 08.15 enforcement time is permanently changed to 08.25.</p>
