Extension of Age Range at Kingham Primary School, Chipping Norton</b></p> <p><i>Forward Plan Ref: 2018/027</i>  <i>Contact: Lucy Mills, Schools Organisation Officer Tel: 07586 478794</i></p> <p>Report by Director for Children's Services (<b>CMDPHE5</b>).</p> <p>The Governing Body of Kingham Primary School, working with the Local Authority, is proposing to alter the school's age range from 4-11 to 2-11, to provide a nursery offering 48 part time equivalent funded places</p> <p>Kingfishers Playgroup, which currently operates on the school site under a lease from the local authority, has voted to close at the end of the summer term 2018. This is due to ongoing pressures in maintaining the voluntary community committee structure, particularly in terms of administrative management and responsibility.
