2. Questions from County Councillors Councillor Jean Fooks “The provision of the toucan crossing at the new Parkway station is very welcome. But the access to this for cyclists remains inadequate. Much wider segregated provision is needed along the Banbury Road both north and south of the station entrance. The number of cycle stands proposed is also seriously inadequate, given how close the station is to centres of population for whom cycling would be easy and convenient. It is County Council policy to encourage cycling over vehicular access, and this is a golden opportunity to do just that. “	Cabinet Member for Environment “Access provision in the Cherwell area to be reviewed prior to the opening of the station. That should result in improved segregation. Further discussions to be held with Chiltern Railways regarding provision of adequate facilities such as cycle stands.
