**Summary of representations in person**

Mr Phipps reported that extensive consultation had been carried out by the design team with the users of the centre and that their ideas had influenced the design of the centre, particularly the recording studio. Further consultation would be carried out as plans were developed and also into the construction phase.

He further reported that the scheme was cost neutral and that the design was low carbon, including low energy fittings and solar panels to generate electricity which can be sold back to the National Grid when the centre is not being used.
