Supplementary Substance Misuse Service</b></p> <p><i>Cabinet Member:</i> Public Health &amp; Equality <i>Forward Plan Ref:</i> 2022/130 <i>Contact:</i> Kate Holburn, Head of Public Health Programmes, 07825 052768</p> <p>Report by Corporate Director for Public Health &amp; Community Safety (<b>CMDPHE4</b>).</p> <p>A number of additional grants, from the Department for Levelling up, Housing and Communities and Office of Health Improvement and Disparities, have been provided to Oxfordshire County Council Public Health Team to enhance substance misuse services, including the Rough Sleeping Drug and Alcohol Treatment Grant (RSDATG) and the Supplementary Substance Misuse Treatment and Recovery Grant (SSMTRG). In August 2022 a new grant was announced, which will commence in November 2022, the Supplementary Substance Misuse Treatment and Recovery <u>Housing Support</u> Grant which Oxfordshire are eligible to receive.
