

PUBLIC NOTICE

Proposed Enlargement of Badgemore Primary School, Henley

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Oxfordshire County Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to Badgemore (Community) Primary School Hop Gardens, Henley-on-Thames, RG9 2HL from 01 September 2012.

Oxfordshire County Council is proposing to enlarge Badgemore Primary School from a 0.5 form entry school to a 1 form entry school. This will require some expansion of the school's buildings.

The current capacity of the school (Years Foundation – Year 6) is 105 and the proposed capacity will be 210. The current number of pupils registered at the school is 86. The current admission number for the school is 15 and the proposed admission number will be 30.
