Proposal to Expand St Blaise CE Primary School, Milton from 0.5FE to 1FE</p> <p><i>Forward Plan Ref: 2019/017</i> <i>Contact: Karen Fowler, Schools Planning Support Officer Tel: 07741 607833</i></p> <p>Report by Director for Children's Services (CMDECS4).</p> <p>Expansion of St Blaise CE Primary School, Milton Heights, is necessary to ensure sufficient primary school places are available for local housing development.</p> <p>Such expansion requires a statutory consultation and decision-making process. A statutory notice has been published, and the required representation period has ended. There have been no objections to the proposed expansion.</p> <p><i>The Cabinet Member for Education & Cultural Services is RECOMMENDED to approve the proposed expansion of St Blaise CE Primary School from September 2020 with the following conditions:</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <i>1. That, prior to 30 June 2019, the necessary land to facilitate the school's expansion has been transferred to the County Council.</i> <i>2.
