Cabinet Member's Comments

The Cabinet member was satisfied with the responses from officers with regard to her questions in relation to the following areas:

- the inclusion of elected members from neighbouring local authorities in the consultation process;
- linkage of the IRMP with the directorate's Business Continuity Review, and with those of other directorates, to ensure that consolidation takes place and they are made current;
- Project 2 could result in the speeding up of the fire fighter recruitment process, without losing the standards and good practice accrued from the personal development system; and
- the implementation of the IRMP, in line with other agencies and other local authorities, in time for the Olympics in July 2012.
