The Cabinet Member for Growth & Infrastructure considered amendments to the previously agreed Household Waste Recycling Centres - Operating, Access and Waste Acceptance Policy to reflect changes in the guidance produced by the Health and Safety Executive regarding the presentation of asbestos and the other to specify a change in guidance under the DIY 123 for Free scheme.
