

HORTON HEALTH OVERVIEW AND SCRUTINY COMMITTEE. 19 SEPTEMBER 2019

Chairman's Report

1. Planning for the meeting of 19th September

- 1.0 A meeting between the Chairman and the Chief Executive and Director of Governance of Oxfordshire Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) with a Policy Officer from Oxfordshire County Council and the Head of Communications from the CCG, took place on the 8th of August, to discuss upcoming items for Oxfordshire HOSC's Forward Plan. During this, the following points were discussed about the Horton HOSC:
- The CCG are confident they have done enough work on small Consultant Led Units (CLU) to understand their models. HOSC's request to small CLUs for provision of information on their models is scheduled to be considered on the 11th of September, which may need to be reflected by the CCG in their consideration/recommendations to the CCG Board in September.
 - Done all the work to make decision at the CCG Board on the 26th September. The Horton HOSC will need a recommendation for their meeting, which will be planned for the 19th of September. The CCG will be able to provide this paper, but will need to be published as an addenda due to the need to simultaneously publish the paper for their own Board meeting.

2. Research on Small Consultant Led Units

- 2.1 At the meeting of the 4th July 2019 Horton HOSC it was agreed to: "invite representatives of other small obstetric-led units to give evidence of how they work to achieve their aims and retain their training accreditation before the September CCG Board meetings." The responses received are contained within Appendix A of this report.
- 2.2. In following up on the information provided in Appendix A, requests were made for additional detail on the medical models and rotas at each of the units in question. At the time of publishing, no additional information was available; should this be provided it will be published as an addenda to the meeting papers for the 19th of September.
