Revocation of Proposal to Establish a Sixth Form at Icknield Community College</p> <p>Report by Director for Children's Services (CMDCEF5).</p> <p>This report seeks to revoke a previous decision.</p> <p>The Cabinet Member for Children, Education & Families approved the previous proposal led by the Governing Body of Icknield Community College to establish a Sixth Form at the College from September 2015. In order for this to happen, the upper age range of the College was to be extended from 16 to 19.</p> <p>Unfortunately, mainly for financial reasons and new developments since the approval was made, the College now considers it not financially viable to open a Sixth Form at the present time. Reasons for this are set out by the College in the Report.</p> <p>A formal revocation of the previous approval is now sought, in order to comply with statutory processes.</p>
