I am delighted with this project as it will remove all remaining temporary buildings from the school site, whilst providing 8 new classrooms, a drama studio, further storage and additional facilities.

I note that the school will be providing a contribution of £100,000 from their Devolved Formula Capital Grant.

I welcome the innovative design that provides for natural passive ventilation and solar shading and heating by an air source heat pump giving significant energy and carbon savings over traditional boiler plan. The design is expected to receive a "Good" rating under the formal BREEAM Schools assessment.
