#### **Cabinet Member's Comments**

I welcome this project which will complete the modernisation of the school to improve suitability and accessibility for children with moderate learning difficulties, together with the provision of a permanent post-16 unit. I am delighted that the school's accommodation will now match up with the 'specialist status' awarded in 2007.

I further welcome the school's contribution of £100,000 for phase 2 of this project, bringing the total school contribution up to well over £250,000.

I am pleased to note that the new building is expected to receive 'very good' under the formal BREEAM schools assessment; is expected to achieve a CO2 reduction of 60% and incorporates a ground source heating system.
