Title of Paper: The future arrangements for NHS commissioning

Purpose: Over the past year, we have been exploring how our organisations can work more effectively to meet our shared ambitions. This work, together with the publication of the NHS Long Term Plan (LTP), has helped to shape our thinking about how future arrangements could look.

The following paper aims to provide the Oxfordshire Joint Health and Overview Scrutiny Committee with an overview of future commissioning arrangements across Buckinghamshire, Oxfordshire and Berkshire West (BOB) and seeks feedback on the proposals.

Each clinical commissioning group in the BOB area is engaging with local people and key stakeholders. In Oxfordshire information about future commissioning arrangements and an online questionnaire have been shared with local NHS staff and GP practices, and with more than 3,500 people through Talking Health, the CCG's online engagement tool. It has been shared via provider trusts with their patient networks and a wider range of stakeholders. Including Healthwatch Oxfordshire, the Local Medical Committee and Oxfordshire councillors. The proposals have also been discussed at various meetings including the Health and Wellbeing Board workshop in November.
