Woodeaton Manor School Alteration of Lower Age Limit

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(3) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Woodeaton Manor School Governing Body intends to make a prescribed alteration to Woodeaton Manor School (Foundation Special), Woodeaton, Oxfordshire OX3 9TS from 01 September 2012.

The Governing Body of Woodeaton Manor School propose to alter the lower age limit of the school to admit a class of primary age pupils (aged 7 to 11) with the same type of special needs as the existing pupils at the school. Woodeaton Manor is a special school for pupils with behavioural, emotional and social disorders (BESD), but has a particular focus on those with emotional and social difficulties. The vast majority of pupils have autistic spectrum disorders. It currently teaches children of secondary school age (11-18). The proposal is to teach the 7 - 18 age range.
