Fire and Rescue Service National Framework 2008-2011

The draft National Framework was published for consultation on **14 November 2007**, and outlines what the Government sees to be the key priorities and objectives for the FRSs over the coming years. The document makes clear what is expected from FRSs, and what support the Government will provide.

FRSs have until 6 February 2008 to submit a consultation response to CLG, either online, by e-mail or by letter (please see website for address).

National Indicators for Local Authorities and Local Authority Partnerships: Handbook of definitions – Draft for Consultation

On 8 November 2007 the Government published the single set of national indicators that will underpin the new performance framework. Consultation on the detailed definitions of these indications is now open to ensure that the methodology for measuring is robust at a local level. The consultation is seeking views of the methodology, how often authorities should be reporting and the data source of each indicator; they are keen to remind us that the consultation is not aimed at seeking views on whether the indicators should be used.

## Audit Commission Comprehensive Area Assessments

On 19 November 2007 the Audit Commission, with partners, published the joint inspectorate consultation on the Comprehensive Areas Assessment (CAA). The document asks for views on a number of issues including: the assessment of risk; how the elements of CAA fit together; the evidence to be used to make as assessment; how it fits with other performance documents, sustainable communities and LAAs; and the role of regional Government Offices.

Consultation of the Comprehensive Area Assessment will close on 15 February 2008. Responses can be submitted to the Audit Commission by e-mail or by letter (please see website for address)..

### **Use of Resources 2009**

The Audit Commission is currently consulting on its proposed approach to use of resources, including the Key Lines of Enquiry (KLOEs) for 2009 assessments. This will be one element of the new CAA framework. Consultation, which opened on 19 November 2007, is looking for local authorities views on the proposed KLOEs and the ways in which scores will be generated.
