PARKING CHARGES OXFORD CITY CENTRE ON-STREET PARKING

Report by Head of Transport

Introduction

- 1. Parking Charges for on-street parking areas in Oxford have not changed since 1998, except for the pilot period of free charging since December 2005. On 8 June 2006 this Committee approved that charging for parking should apply only Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm. At certain locations where the charging period was shorter than this, that remains unchanged.
- 2. Oxford City Council increased parking charges for equivalent periods of stay for central car parks to £1.80 for 1 hour and £3 for 2 hours in 2005. Oxford City Council is currently considering a further increase to £1.90 for the 1 hourly rate, with no change to the 2 hourly rate.
- 3. The Transport Implementation Committee is now asked to consider the two options to increase parking charges in table 1 and table 2.

4. A higher rate for the period 8am to 10am Monday to Saturday/Friday, could encourage people to either use Park & Ride car parks, local bus services or travel into the city centre outside the peak morning travel period. Traffic flows are typically highest between 7.30 – 9.30am and 4.30 - 6.30pm.

Parking charges - applicable time periods

- 5. Under the pilot-parking scheme for Oxford the removal of charge was implemented for a trial period of 6 months (1 December 31 May 2006) in order to gauge the effects. Monday to Saturday parking charges were removed after 6.30pm, with no limit on the period of stay and the charge removed all day for parking on Sundays. A few streets have a maximum stay of 3hrs and these limits have been retained.
- 6. An increase in charges will apply to all time periods charged for, as approved on 8 June (Agenda Item TIC6 *Pilot Parking Charges Oxford City Centre*).

How the project supports LTP2 objectives

7. It has always been part of the policy of the Oxford Transport Strategy to retain a balance between parking charges, bus fares and park & ride charges in order to make the alternatives to private car attractive. This increase in the car parking on-street tariff helps to maintain that balance.

Financial and Staff Implications

8. No long-term staff implications are anticipated although some short-term impact from an increase in dealing with complaints for Parking Control Team is possible.

Financial Implications (including Revenue)

9. It is anticipated that the increase in charges should generate an additional parking revenue, of £150,000 to £300,000 per annum, based on charging from 8.00 am to 6.30pm Monday to Saturday compared against the income collected at the current rate of charging for the same time periods. This is calculated on approximate turnover figures at parking areas measured during surveys. An allowance has been made for a reduction in the amount of people choosing to park before 10am. An additional allowance has been made for some reduction in numbers parking due to the increase in charges throughout the day. This is an estimate based on likely reaction to the change in charges; the number parking at this time may begin to increase again in the medium term. This comparison is made on equivalent charging time periods and not against previous year income overall as the charging time periods have changed. The income estimates for Option 1 and 2 are still within the range given above, this is because charging at Option 1 rate is likely to result in a greater reduction in parking numbers between 8am and 10am, at least in the short term.

RECOMMENDATION

- 10. The Committee is RECOMMENDED to consider either:
 - (a) Option One as set out in table one above and those streets listed at Annex 1 to this report; or
 - (b) Option Two as set out in table two above and those streets listed at Annex1 to this report;

as a basis for changes to parking charges for on-street public parking at pay and display areas for implementation from 1 October 2006.
