Summary of representations in person

Prior to consideration of the item, Mr John Townend and his son, a member of the Oxford Junior Ice Hockey Club, addressed the Cabinet Member in support of the application from the Club for grant aid to increase numbers attending with a view to making the club more financially viable. He pointed out that 2012/13 had seen 200-300 children come to take part in free, one hourly sessions during which they had access to free equipment and free coaching, regardless of their means. A small number of these children/young people had subsequently joined the Club, one of whom was his son, and thus paid fees. The Club hoped to continue this successful venture into 2014/15. Mr Townend's son commented on how much enjoyment he had experienced since joining the Club for the preliminary free sessions, how enthusiastic the coaches were, and how rewarding it was to be part of a team.
