Cabinet Member's Comments

Cllr Mrs Heathcoat commented that she believed it to be common sense that this interim arrangement be brought in to allow new procurement arrangements to be introduced; in order to avoid unnecessary disruption to clients; and to allow this procurement to be synchronised. She also declared herself satisfied, following her questioning of Mr Wood, that there would be long term savings from the contracts.
