# **Summary of representations in person**

Mr Travis in introducing the report outlined the projects that were to be put forward for consultation for inclusion in the CRMP Action Plan for the fiscal year 2015-16. In answer to a question from the Cabinet Member, Mr Travis confirmed that the priorities had been agreed upon by the Fire & Rescue Strategic Leadership Team and that the 'Adverse weather' included snow, heat wave and flooding and that they had developed emergency planning and highways for community resilience including sandbag dumps, road signage and community flood advisors.

In response to further questions Mr Travis confirmed that links had been set up with the district councils, Thames Valley Police, Ambulance Service and Social & Community Services.

It is very important to continue to improve links in relation to adverse weather. Could I ask that Locality Groups are kept informed.
