## Annual Report of the Director of Public Health 2017/18

## <u>Recommendations from the Oxfordshire Joint Health Overview &</u> <u>Scrutiny Committee from its meeting on 20 September 2018,</u> <u>Cabinet on 16 October 2018 and Council on 6 November 2018</u>

The Oxfordshire Joint Health Overview & Scrutiny Committee considered the annual Report of the Director of Public Health at its meeting on 13 September 2018 and agreed the following recommendations for Cabinet:

To:

- (a) ask Cabinet to consider lobbying the Government for a minimum price on alcohol and a watershed of 9pm for the advertising of fast food on TV; and
- (b) recommend Cabinet to ensure that there is an evaluation of the Healthy Towns project when it comes to an end and also to ensure decisions are made on how to spread the learning arising from the project.

The Board is asked to note that Cabinet, at its meeting on 16 October 2018 resolved to recommend Council to receive the report and note its recommendations, including the recommendations of the Oxfordshire Joint Health Overview & Scrutiny Committee.

Council, on 6 November 2018 resolved to receive the report and noted its recommendations. In relation to recommendation (a) above from the Oxfordshire Joint Health Overview & Scrutiny Committee, the Cabinet Member for Adult Social Care & Public Health indicated that he was happy to send a letter to the Government, but that the draft letter be considered by the Oxfordshire Health & Wellbeing Board and the Health Improvement Board prior to sending (letter to follow).

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
