Re: Proposed move of Moorfields Eye Hospital's City Road services: Post-consultation decision-making process and timetable

As the election period has passed and we have a new government, we are progressing with the decision-making process and timetable for the Moorfields relocation proposal, following the consultation which ended on 16 September 2019.

Update on current status

- Moorfields and its partners, the UCL Institute of Ophthalmology and Moorfields Eye Charity, are
 proposing to build a new centre bringing together excellent eye care, with ground-breaking research
 and education. The preferred location is a site that has become available at the St Pancras Hospital
 site, just north of King's Cross and St Pancras stations in central London.
- The proposal, called Oriel, was the subject of a public consultation from 24 May to 16 September 2019. For more information, please visit www.oriel-london.org.uk.

A draft report summarising the findings from consultation was published on the Oriel website on 23 October 2019 to give people the opportunity to comment before publishing the final report. We are grateful to all those who have given feedback and whose comments have been taken into account for the publication of the final report in January 2020.

Engagement with CCGs and their corresponding local authorities has been an important part of the pre-consultation and consultation process. Different levels of engagement were undertaken for the different audiences, dependent on the extent of potential impact of services relocating from the Moorfields City Road site.

A comprehensive summary of the findings from the consultation, our response to the findings and other decision-making information, such as service modelling, financial planning, and the integrated health inequality and equality impact assessment, will be presented to a Joint Health Overview and Scrutiny Committee (JHOSC) comprised of the five local authorities in north central London, at its meeting in public, on **31 January 2020**.

This view will then be shared with the CCGs' Committees-in-Common which will consider the outcome of the consultation and the Decision-Making Business Case at its meeting on 12 February

2020. This will be in parallel to the decision-making process for NHS England Specialised Commissioning.
