















## What is an electoral review?

Names of each division






During this phase, we ask for you to make your case for a particular number of councillors

Every council is unique. The Commission does not have a policy as to whether the number of councillors should go up, go down, or stay the same.

21 February 2023 - 1 May 2023


Consultation on draft proposals:
