WEST HENDRED: A417 READING ROAD – PROPOSED PUFFIN CROSSING & BUS STOP CLEARWAYS

Report by Director of Environment and Highways

RECOMMENDATION

The Cabinet Member is RECOMMENDED to:

Approve the following features on the A417 Reading Road, in West Hendred as advertised:

- a) Puffin Crossing located approx. 30 metres east of the junction with The Greenway, and
- b) Bus Stop Clearways at the bus stops on the north and south sides of the A417 in the vicinity of the Puffin Crossing.

Executive Summary

- 1. This report presents responses received to a statutory consultation on proposals to: a) construct a new a Puffin Crossing (signal-controlled crossing for use by pedestrians only) in West Hendred on the A417 Reading Road, located approx. 30 metres east of the junction with The Greenway, and b) new Bus Stop Clearways (with associated 'No Stopping except local buses' restrictions) on the north and south sides of the A417 in the vicinity of the Puffin Crossing, as shown in **Annex 1.**
- 2. It should be noted that the current position of the bus stop for eastbound buses marked/circled as 'A' in **Annex 1** is currently being reviewed taking account of a recommendation in the road safety audit report for the scheme, and it is possible that this will be relocated to the east side of the Puffin Crossing as marked/circled 'B'.
- 3. Officers are carrying out further work on this point of detail and will carry out a local consultation with the Bus Company, Local Member and Parish Council.

Financial Implications

4. Funding for consultation on the proposals (and implementation if approved) has been provided by the County Council's Accessibility & Road Safety budget.

Legal Implications

- 5. The consultation that has been undertaken complies with the consultation requirements for the various elements as required by law including under the Highways Act 1980, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and any other related regulations.
- 6. If approved, the scheme would be introduced by Oxfordshire County Council as the Traffic Authority and Highway Authority.

Equality and Inclusion Implications

7. No implications in respect of equalities or inclusion have been identified in respect of the proposals.

Sustainability Implications

8. The proposed Puffin crossing will improve safety for pedestrians, particularly schoolchildren, crossing the A417 to and from the bus stops. The crossing will also facilitate residents on the north side of the A417 in crossing the road to access the main body of the village and community facilities such as the Village Hall and the Playground.

Formal Consultation

- 9. Formal consultation was carried out between 09 October and 08 November 2024. A notice was published in the Oxfordshire Herald Series newspaper, and an email was sent to statutory consultees & key-stakeholders, including Thames Valley Police, the Fire & Rescue Service, Ambulance service, Bus operators, countywide transport / access & disabled peoples user groups, Vale of White Horse District Council, local District Cllr's, West Hendred Parish Council, and the local County Councillor representing the Hendreds & Harwell division.
- 10. Public notices were also placed on site, in the immediate vicinity of the proposals.

- 11. Relevant parish/town councils, and local Cllrs (including County, District, Parish, Town) were also encouraged to use the consultation documents provided to publicise the proposals locally amongst residents as necessary.
- 12.182 responses were received via the online consultation survey during the course of the formal consultation, and these are summarised in the table below:

- 13. Additionally, a further two emails were received, with Thames Valley Police not objecting providing that speed monitoring had taken place, and that the crossing meets all necessary design standards. Oxford Bus Company submitting their strong support, citing the operational & safety benefits to users of local bus services.
- 14. The responses are shown at **Annex 2** and copies of the original responses are available for inspection by County Councillors.

Officer Response to Objections/Concerns

- 15. The majority of the objections received to the proposed Puffin crossing raised concerns with the impact on the flow of traffic and an increase in delays travelling along the route.
- 16. The remaining objections relating to the proposed Puffin crossing cited no apparent demand, vehicle speeds being too high, and too much traffic on the road for the crossing to be safe.
- 17. The A417 Reading Road is a busy 'A' class principal road carrying approximately 15,600 vehicles when measured as a 2-way 5-day average (Mon-Fri). The road has a 30 mph posted speed limit which was introduced in November 2023. Previous to this the road was subject to a 40 mph posted speed limit. The latest speed survey results obtained for the proposed crossing indicate the mean and 85%ile speeds as 32.7mph & 37.1mph eastbound and 31.5mph & 36.8mph westbound.
- 18. Road Traffic collision history shows a recorded personal injury collision occurring in January 2022 where a schoolchild sustained a serious injury whilst crossing the road to catch a school bus.
- 19. The proposed Puffin crossing is primarily intended to provide safer crossing facilities for schoolchildren that cross the A417 south to north in the AM peak, where the traffic volume is nose to tail in both directions, to catch the eastbound

school bus. Officers have recently observed the number of students using the eastbound school bus being in the region of 12. This pattern is reversed in the afternoon PM peak for students returning to West Hendred from Wantage. Outside of the morning and afternoon peak periods officers expect use of the crossing will be minimal.

- 20. It should also be noted that the proposed Puffin crossing will provide improved connectivity between the different parts of West Hendred village lying either side of the A417 Reading Road as well as providing safer access for people using the scheduled service buses travelling between Didcot and Wantage.
- 21. The strategic importance of the A417 both in terms of linking communities and network resilience is acknowledged by the County Council. The design of the proposed Puffin crossing will incorporate both pedestrian and vehicle detection equipment to adjust the amount of time traffic is held on a red signal. Should the pedestrian demand button be pressed but the pedestrian choses to cross without waiting for the green signal to proceed, the duration traffic will be held on a red signal will automatically be reduced accordingly. Similarly, should the detection equipment register an approach vehicle travelling in excess of the posted speed limit the signal timings will automatically be adjusted to allow the vehicle to pass safely or to come to a safe stop.
- 22. Officers consider the objections raised to the proposed Puffin crossing have been addressed in the design and future operation of the facility.
- 23. Objections were also received for the proposal to introduce a clearway provision at the existing eastbound and westbound bus stops located to the west of the proposed Puffin crossing. These objections cited the impact of the proposed clearways on traffic.
- 24. The intention of proposed bus stop clearways is to prohibit anything but a public service vehicle from stopping and waiting at each of the bus stops. Therefore, the concerns raised by the objectors to the clearways do not reflect the intention of the proposal nor the current situation that buses already stop on the A417 to pick up and set down passengers.
- 25. As previously noted by officers, there are both school buses and scheduled service buses using the bus stops adjacent to the proposed Puffin crossing, and keeping these free from indiscriminate parking is key.



RESPONDENT	COMMENTS
(1) Traffic Management Officer, (Thames Valley Police	No objection – The Police have no objection providing that speed monitoring has taken place, and this crossing meets all necessary design standards.
(2) Head of Built Environment and Infrastructure, (Oxford Bus Company)	Support – The proposals involve the substantial upgrade of bus stops on the A417 served among other things by the principal bus route we operate between Grove Wantage and Harwell, thereafter, continuing to Didcot. The X35 runs every 30 minutes Monday-Friday and hourly on Saturdays and Sundays. These stops are the only ones that serve the village the bulk of which lies a walk to the south. They thus are key to offering access to bus services to the whole community of West Hendred. Naturally, we wish to record our strong support for these proposals. Among other things there are strong safety merits to the project, both for bus passengers and pedestrians in general, notably those properties lying north of the A417 who experience a degree of severance from the rest of the village.
(3) County Cllr, (Hendreds & Harwell division)	Puffin crossing – Support This crossing is needed desperately, we have already had one physical incident and many other near misses of young children and our vulnerable residents. We have waited for this crossing for far too long. Thank you Bus-stop clearways – Support I support the proposals
(4) Local resident, (Grove)	Puffin crossing – Object Will cause more accidents and the traffic will be even worse Bus-stop clearways – Object Again will cause more issues

(5) Local resident, (Harry, Wantage, Springfield Road)	Puffin crossing – Object Ridiculous place to put a set of traffic lights, the speed limit has already been lowered to 30 mph, I drive that road multiple times a day and rarely see anyone waiting to cross! Bus-stop clearways – Object Ridiculous place to put a set of traffic lights, the speed limit has already been lowered to 30 mph, I drive that road multiple times a day and rarely see anyone waiting to cross! I also see hardly anyone waiting for a bus in this area. Busses stopping where they do doesn't cause hardly any traffic now anyway.
(6) Local resident, (Wantage, Brundle Way)	Puffin crossing – Object The traffic on Reading Road through this area during commuting hours is already bad enough, adding a crossing such as this will make this drastically worse. Bus-stop clearways – Object The traffic on Reading Road through this area during commuting hours is already bad enough, adding this will make this drastically worse.
(7) Local resident, (Wantage, Ham Road)	Puffin crossing – Object The road is too narrow and too much traffic Bus-stop clearways – Object The road is too narrow too much traffic a bypass would be a much more sensible proposal

(9) Member of public, (Wantage, Truelocks Way)	Puffin crossing – Object With all the reduced speed limits and increased traffic soon it will be impossible to get anywhere. There cannot be that many people who actually want to use it. Given how much they cost money would be better spent elsewhere Bus-stop clearways – Object Unless it is off the main carriageway it will further slow traffic
(10) Local resident, (Wantage, Garston Lane)	Puffin crossing – Object Road is too fast and there is no point if there is no Pub open. Bus-stop clearways – Support will keep traffic flowing
(11) Local resident, (Wantage, Wilkins Way)	Puffin crossing – Object Cause traffic delays Bus-stop clearways – Support Improve traffic and safety
(12) Local resident, (West Hendred, The Greenway)	Puffin crossing – Object This junction is dangerous. Our next door neighbour's child was knocked over and lucky not to die. We have seen many accidents on this section of road. It is now also becoming dangerous to pull out from the village given the volume and speed of traffic. Bus-stop clearways – Support See previous comment
(13) Local resident, (Ginge)	Puffin crossing – Partially support The principle of improving road safety for people (including children) crossing the road is absolutely correct. Action is essential and needed promptly.

(15) Member of public, (Ardington, Ardington)	Puffin crossing – Support As a user at the Ardington turn I know how harzardous it is you cross this road (even more so at the Ardington turn where speed limit is 50 and vision from Wantage along this road is bad). Bus-stop clearways – No objection

	Anything to help keep public safe
(16) Local resident, (Ardington, High st)	Puffin crossing – Support The A 417 is busy past all recognition these days, with all the new housing in Wantage. Crossing the road is incredibly dangerous for both children going to and from school and elderly people catching the bus into Didcot or Wantage. A crossing both in West Hendred and also in Ardington is urgently needed. Bus-stop clearways – No objection Good idea if it make the traffic run smoothly
(17) Local resident, (Ardington, No road name)	Puffin crossing – Support The road is getting busier and with more housing developments will become more so. It's tricky enough for motorists to find a space to move out at peak times, let alone pedestrians to cross safely. Bus-stop clearways – No objection Seems sensible but not sure what it entails.
(18) Local resident, (Ardington, Townend)	Puffin crossing – Support It is very dangerous for children crossing the road to catch the bus Bus-stop clearways – No objection I'm neutral about this.
(19) Member of public, (Cholsey, Newlands Way)	Puffin crossing – Support Because it is a busy main road separating 2 parts of a village, for the sake of harmony in the community and safety for the residents a crossing would be important. It wouldn't be used frequently enough to cause traffic jams, but on the occasions it is used it would be life saving. It could also have a deeper impact in allowing the community to support local business such as The Hare which has struggled to remain open during the last few years as passing trade only goes so far for a business like that. Ultimately it needs support of the local village and that would be made more accessible and safer if there was a crossing.

Bus-stop clearways – No objection The road has always been extremely dangerous for school children to cross and they are dropped off outside the pub The Hare. It is even worse in the winter months when it is dark.
(22) Local Cllr, (East Hendred, Horn Lane)	Puffin crossing – Support The A417 is a very busy road. Having a controlled crossing will enhance the safety of people crossing the road. The Puffin crossings on the A417 at East Hendred have shown the need for controlled crossings. Bus-stop clearways – No objection I assume the clearways will make operating the buses easier.
(23) Local resident, (East Hendred, Wantage, Church St)	Puffin crossing – Support Safety of children and adults crossing the road. The traffic is often extremely busy and even when not drivers go too quickly. There have already been accidents and collisions here. The solution is simple. For road works they seem to

	have extensive safety with myriad traffic lights and vast coned off areas, often for a very small hole. It would be mad not to do this. Bus-stop clearways – No objection The crossing seems the most important thing.
(24) Local resident, (Harwell, Kings lane)	Puffin crossing – Support Sounds a great idea given the amount of homes being built. Perhaps do similar on the Reading road in Harwell!! Bus-stop clearways – No objection I don't know what one is
(25) Local resident, (Lockinge, West Hendred)	Puffin crossing – Support Dangerous for school children to cross and residents. Help to slow traffic down many don't reduce their speed. Bus-stop clearways – No objection Work in west Hendred, many fatalities and accidents. Only safe way for school children to cross is if traffic is stopped
(26) Member of public, (Stow on the wold, Icomb)	Puffin crossing – Support Very dangerous at present for school children, and adults, to cross the A417 after alighting from buses. Motorists cannot see pedestrians unless wearing hi viz jackets especially if in the dark or in wet conditions. Bus-stop clearways – No objection Buses are an important link for villagers.
(27) Local resident, (Wantage, Mill Street)	Puffin crossing – Support Despite the road being a 30, drivers still speed through and it's dangerous for pedestrians to cross. A pedestrian would make this safer and could save lives Bus-stop clearways – No objection No particular comment

(28) Member of public, (Wantage, St Mary's)	Puffin crossing – Support That part of the A417 is a dangerous road, with poor visibility for both pedestrians and drivers. Installing a puffin crossing (or an alternative option) would help to slow traffic and make the road a bit safer for all users. It might also have the added advantage of helping the village pub, located on the other side of the A417 from most of the village, remain in business, as it is constantly changing hands - possibly because it is difficult for many residents to safely reach it. Bus-stop clearways – No objection No views either way
(29) Member of public, (Wantage, Warmans Close)	Puffin crossing – Support I'm not sure why there hasn't been a crossing there previously. I drive that road regularly to and from Wantage and often see children and more elderly adults trying to cross after getting off the bus. And now the 30 limit is in place - much easier/safer to stop. (30) Local resident, (West Hendred, Ginge rd)	Puffin crossing – Support Necessary measure due to the urbanisation and over-development of this once rural area Bus-stop clearways – No objection necesary measure due to the overdevelopment of this once rural area
(31) Local resident, (West Hendred, Ginge Road)	Puffin crossing – Support I have lived in the village for 24 years. As a school child I had countless near misses trying to cross the road when dropped back from school. As an adult now who drives, I have also had countless near misses of children darting across the road because they have no other choice. I'm surprised there hasn't been a serious accident already

	Bus-stop clearways – No objection Not sure if needed
(32) Local resident, (West Hendred, Ginge Road)	Puffin crossing – Support My daughter will in the future be required to cross the road to reach the bus stop for school and so I would feel far more comfortable with her doing that on a dedicated crossing. I drive past that location on the drive to work and frequently see school children crossing there and it seems more precarious that it needs to be. Bus-stop clearways – No objection No strong feelings either way
(33) Local resident, (West Hendred, Ginge Road)	Puffin crossing – Support Gives safe access to the bus stop and pub for everyone in the village Bus-stop clearways – No objection I don't mind either way
(34) Local resident, (West Hendred, Greenway)	Puffin crossing – Support This crossing has been needed and campaigned for for years, possibly over 20yrs. It is only a matter of time before someone dies trying to cross. Bus-stop clearways – No objection No objection
(35) Local resident, (West Hendred, The Greenway)	Puffin crossing – Support It is a crossing used by school children. With all the house building, the traffic has increased and despite the efforts of the local authority traffic persistently breaks the speed limit and there is often overtaking at the at the junction. It is not lit so it is particularly dangerous in the winter. Bus-stop clearways – No objection

	This makes it clear to motorists that there is a bus stop.
(36) Local resident, (West Hendred, The Greenway)	Puffin crossing – Support Busy road - especially at rush hour times. Regular pick up and drop off point for school children in the village, catching the bus. (Including my own children.) Puffin crossing should provide a safer means to cross the road. Bus-stop clearways – No objection I'm not clear on the necessity of the Bus Stop Clearways. As the bus already stops in this position, and there is no parking problem at this point.
(37) Local resident, (West Hendred, The Greenway)	Puffin crossing – Support We need it!! I am disabled and when I use the bus there is no dropped curb to cross the road meaning my daughter has to push my wheelchair down someone's drive and on to the Greenway to walk up to the junction with the A417 and cross there and or vice versa depending if I am going to Wantage or Didcot. Also it is a very busy road and even with the 30mph speed limit it can be difficult to judge when it is safe to cross. Bus-stop clearways – No objection Not sure why we need this as we have a bus stop sign there already but I have no objection.
(38) Local resident, (West Hendred, Bankside)	Puffin crossing – Support I have 3 school age children who need to use buses and therefore will always have to try to cross the A417. This road is always busy and feels as an adult like you could be struck in either direction by a passing vehicle, most of which are not abiding the speed limits, let alone a child. A crossing would be the answer to allow us to safely use public transport and if it is open enjoy the local village pub Bus-stop clearways – No objection Child safety

(39) Local resident, (West Hendred, Ginge road)	Puffin crossing – Support I support as I see every day children running as quickly as they can across the A417 to avoid fast traffic to catch a buss. More accidents are just waiting to happen. Bus-stop clearways – No objection I support
(40) Local resident, (West Hendred, The Greenway)	Puffin crossing – Support Crossing the road at this point feels unsafe. This road requires regular pedestrian crossing to access the bus stop, pub and public rights of way. Bus-stop clearways – No objection I will benefit personally from the installation of a proper crossing and I believe it will improve the safety of the road at this point
(41) Local resident, (East Hendred, Ludbridge Close)	Puffin crossing – Support This is a very dangerous area with many accidents happening. The bus stops support the local villages and makes it hard for people and children to cross. A crossing here would facilitate a safer route for all. It may also slow down the traffic in this area as well. Bus-stop clearways – Partially support Traffic is often stalled on a very busy route either due to buses or cyclists. This could help the flow of traffic.
(42) Local resident, (Ginge, Ginge)	Puffin crossing – Support Strongly support this proposal. Essential for safe road crossing for all residents especially school children. A417 is increasingly busy with all the recent developments around Wantage with nose to tail traffic for much of the rush hour times. Bus-stop clearways – Partially support I don't feel these are truly necessary as there is never any parking on this section of road

(43) Local resident, (Ginge, Ginge Road)	Puffin crossing – Support I support this because the crossing is dangerous - especially for unaccompanied children using the bus service. The recently imposed speed limit of 30 mph on the A417 is by no means universally respected which adds to the level of danger. Bus-stop clearways – Partially support I have never seen a car stop/park on the A417 at either of the bus stops.
(44) Local resident, (Wantage, Elizabeth Drive)	Puffin crossing – Support This is a very fast and dangerous road despite the recent lowering of the speed limit to 30mph. I have driven daily along this road for 57 years and it has had numerous accidents including deaths on this stretch. With the bus stops on each side of the road now it has become a very difficult road to cross as a pedestrian and sometimes I have found it near impossible with so much traffic. The turning down to West Hendred adds to additional congestion and a pedestrian crossing would effectively slow traffic down to enable safe crossing. School children wait at these bus bus stops it would be essential yo have a pelican crossing with stop lights. A crossing with flashing lights would be far too dangerous. Traffic needs to be made to stop for the safe crossing of school children and the public. A similar crossing with traffic lights further along the A417 in East Hendred was installed fairly recently and has proved very successful and all traffic observes it. Bus-stop clearways – Partially support Unsure if this would hold up traffic. If it did would it mean that there was impatient unsafe overtaking?
(45) Local resident, (West Hendred, Ginge Road)	Puffin crossing – Support My 9 and 11 yr old have to cross every day for school bus. The road is very dangerous and few drivers observe the new 30 mph zone. I go daily to help them cross. Bus-stop clearways – Partially support They would be helpful, particularly on the north side of the road as bus drivers regularly miss the stop as the stop itself is not very visible.

(46) Local resident, (West Hendred, Ginge road)	Puffin crossing – Support Safety when crossing Bus-stop clearways – Partially support I don't really know what that would look like
(47) Local resident, (West Hendred, The Greenway)	Puffin crossing – Support There is a definite need for the crossing considering the need for public bus users, school bus users, walkers and pub users when the pub reopens to regularly cross. As I drive to work, I do not often cross there myself but can see how it must be very difficult to particularly at rush hour, judging by how busy the route has become - likely to only become even more of an issue with the housing developments in Wantage. Bus-stop clearways – Partially support I would like to support anything that encourages the use of public transport and which may make it easier and safer to catch the bus from the village. I do not have a great deal of familiarity with bus stop clear ways however and whether there may be any negative aspects associated with introducing them. I am sure it is a well thought out, realistic proposition however.
(48) As part of a group/organisation, (Abingdon, Bostock Road)	Puffin crossing – Support CoHSAT, the Coalition for Healthy Streets and Active Travel, supports this proposal, which facilitates walking and wheeling trips for people of all ages and abilities across this busy road. Bus-stop clearways – Support CoHSAT, the Coalition for Healthy Streets and Active Travel views public transport, including buses, as a key part of an integrated, sustainable transport system. Buses should be prioritised to help their services be reliable and easy to use. Thus, we support the bus stop clearways.
(49) Local resident, (Ardington, Masons court)	Puffin crossing – Support Safety Bus-stop clearways – Support

	It's a good idea
(50) Local resident, (Ardington, Rickyard)	Puffin crossing – Support In full support of this. It's a treacherous fast road and very dangerous for all to cross on a regular basis. Bus-stop clearways – Support Full support it's a busy treacherous road for anyone to cross on a regular basis
(51) Local resident, (Ardington, The Firs)	Puffin crossing – Support Road safety and avoidance of road traffic accidents involving residents and particularly young people trying to cross this busy road to get to and from school buses.
